7.27.20 Middle School Specific

School Delivery Model	Students will attend school every day, honoring the district-adopted calendar. Alternating Fridays will include early release for all students.
Pick-Up and Drop-Off	No earlier than 7:40 and no later than 3:35 for CCMS No earlier than 7:30 and no later than 3:25 for Harrison
Length of Day	7 hours and 30 minutes
Start/Stop Times	7:55 a.m. to 3:25 p.m.--CCMS 7:45 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.--Harrison Early release time will remain at 1:35 for CCMS and 1:15 for Harrison on alternating Fridays.
Grouping of Students	Students will be grouped by Cohort
Content Area Focus	By using our unique rotation schedule, all content areas will be met every week
Breakfast/Lunch	Students come to the cafeteria in cohorts to pick up <i>Grab and Go</i> or contactless traditional meals. Students eat with their cohort in the classroom or other specified area.
Recess	Lunches will be staggered and students will stay in cohort groups during lunch recess or any other recess breaks throughout the day.
Full Online Option	6th-8th grade students/parents that wish to opt into the online-only option for the 20-21SY will first need to be registered in their appropriate district school. Once enrolled in their area school, they will need to fill out the Online-Only Registration form (will be provided to the public beginning the week of 7/27). This registration form will allow building Administrators to see which of their students has chosen this option for the sake of records For the Online-Only option, students will be rostered in their normal classes for the 20-21SY as if they were attending them in person. This will then automatically roster them into Schoology (which will be used to provide the online learning) This option will allow the students that are online-only to receive the same educational experience, following the same curriculum and learning as their peers that will be in person. Teachers can even host a

Attendance	Taken daily in all cohorts.
Grades	Traditional.
Athletics & Activities	Following CHSAA guidance. Eligibility returns to normal.
Social Emotional Learning	District-provided SEL program married with our Youth Connections grant program. BIMAS social-emotional survey as students return (schedule varies per school). A <i>Youth Truth</i> survey will be conducted in September.
Special Education	Teachers will follow IEP guidelines. As per CDE guidelines, special service providers do not need to be included in the teacher-to-classroom ratios. They will minimize contact with non-client students and other adults in classrooms. Students must receive services within their cohorts.
